Bid – A signed offer or proposal to undertake a contract submitted by a bidder in response to and in consonance with the requirements of the bidding documents. Also referred to as Proposal and Tender: (2016) revised IRR, Section 5[c])

Bidder – Refers to a contractor; manufacturer; supplier; distributor and/or consultant who submits a bid in response to the requirements of the Bidding Documents (2016 revised IRR, Section5[d])

Bidding Documents – The documents issued by the Procuring Entity as the bases for bids, furnishing all information necessary for a prospective bidden to prepare a bid for the Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and/or Consulting Services required by the Procuring Entity. (2016 newised IRR, Section 5[e])
